

Turn in your Bibles to John 8 verse 31 and follow along:



Introduction

Strong Words: The Leaders had brought strong words to Jesus and here He spoke strong words back. The **right** strong words define and clarify rather than confront and declare. Key verses in prior dialogue: See John 8:24; if you don't believe you will die in your sins. The response: some believed (8:30)

1. John 8:31-32

This is about freedom defined...It is spoken to believers. IF you "Abide" - dwell, remain, keep growing in My words... THEN the truth, His truth, will make you free.

2. John 8:33-36

The leaders claimed they have "Never been in bondage?" (Self-deception in an unconverted man is great).

But Jesus says if they sin, they are "Slaves to sin". SEE more details from Paul - Romans 6. Also see Galatians 5, and see 2

Peter 2:19. So the truth is that the Son sets us free - FREE INDEED! That is the Gospel...Set free from the penalty of death, the power of sin, and the presence of sin in eternity.

3. John 8:37-40 Confronting Inconsistency

You are Abraham's descendants and yet you seek to kill me. This is inconsistent with Abraham. He wouldn't do that. Their attitudes and actions were inconsistent with Abraham. **Are we like that too when we say we follow Jesus?** Are we inconsistent in what words we use, with what Jesus says? Words and names are not enough!

4. John 8:41-47 Confronting lies

Here we have insults based on rumors. They wanted to smear the messenger, knock him off. Jesus responded: "You are NOT ABLE to listen"...confronting their hard heartedness. In fact you are unwilling to receive truth! They were believing lies (source identified as the devil). You have no record of sin against me. You have the Words of truth but you aren't believing.

5. John 8:48-53 Name calling & insults

Now they are name calling saying to Jesus you are a "Samaritan" & "have a demon". Jesus responds: IF you keep My Word = you will never see death. (Spiritual death). This only makes sense if Jesus is God. They respond Whoa! Abraham and prophets all died. "Who do you make yourself out to be?"

6. John 8:54-59 Final declaration

Honor is from God. Abraham rejoiced to see My day!! See Genesis 17 – Announcement of a coming son Genesis 18 - pronounces judgment on Sodom. Possibly others. Jesus responds: "I AM" Before Abraham was, "I AM" This was an eternal claim. See Exodus 3:13-15 – I AM is the name of God. I AM is the title of Deity...his name forever. These are the Strongest Words!

Conclusions:

-Strong words are sometimes necessary...When we speak...Be careful: Is it True or just our opinion?

Are our words Spirit directed (patient, kind, gentle....)

Some people want Answers and some Arguments. See: Proverbs 26:4-5 Listen carefully and respond correctly.

What is REAL freedom?

People search in many ways and many places, but it is only found in Jesus Unbelief, hard hearts, pride...That is the core of sin "I AM" = Jesus is God = The "STRONGEST WORDS" of truth!
